Complementary actions for the Reconstruction of a District Hospital in Manjil and the Expansion of the Rural Hospital in Abbar Taroum

LOCATION

Provinces of Gilan and Zanjan, Iran

CLIENT

DESCRIPTION

On June 21st, 1990, an earthquake devastated the provinces of **Gilan** and **Zanjan** (60.000 km²) with heavy damage to houses and public infrastructure and loss of some 3,500 lives.

In order to provide **health facilities** in these two areas, the European Commission agreed in 1991 to finance the construction of two small district hospitals in **Manjil (64 beds)** and **Abbar Taroum (32 beds)** in the provinces of Gilan and Zanjan in Northern Iran. At that time, a project of 13 MECU was approved, which was completed in 1998 at a final cost of 9 MECU.

Scope of the present project is to put in place some **complementary actions** required for deriving **maximum benefit** from the investment realised to date, using the balances of that project.

The project involves the **implementation** of the following components:

- **Housings** at Manjil and Abbar Tarroun
- **Three Emergency Stations** (Rostamabad, Lousham, Gilvan)
- **Three Rural Health Centres** (Mikal, Gilvan and Shahre Bizar)
- **Blood Bank** at Roudbar
- **Priority Equipment** for Manjil and for Abbar Taroum
- **Ambulances** for 7 Rural Health Centres
- **Maintenance Inventory** for Manjil and Abbar Taroum



Services to be provided by the Consultant, ADK and BETAPLAN, in the framework of a **Technical Assistance Services** Contract for the **implementation** of the above complementary actions are:

1. **Final Design** and **Tender Documents** of the above project components (**civil works** and **medical equipment**);
2. **Evaluation of Tenders** and **recommendation for Tender Award**;
3. **Supervision** of the **works** during **implementation phase**;
4. Supervision of the installation of Medical Equipment;
5. **Development** of a **Maintenance Inventory** for Medical Equipment.
