DESCRIPTION

Scope of the study is the completion of the existing **Auditorium I building**, of **section V**, situated within the Mathematics/Physics School Complex at the Athens University Campus, as well as its **transformation** into a **Library of Unique/Rare Books** of the School. This Library will closely **cooperate** with the **main Library**, the construction of which is currently under completion, located at the neighbouring building of the Auditorium.

Services Provided:

1. **Architectural design**,
2. **Structural study** for examining the structural adequacy of the existing bearing structure and determining the structural reinforcement,
3. **Study of the electrical and mechanical installations** (general air-conditioning, water supply, sewerage, fire detection and fire protection systems, etc) of the building and the **external surrounding areas** as well as studies for the **protection** of the **Library's contents** (systems for access control, tele-management, anti-robbery and protection of rare books),
4. **Preparation of tender documents**,
5. **Landscaping design**.
